

Documents For Italian Visa

A time to reflect on my seventy years of life. Maybe some folks will be interested in my life and the folks I have met, or maybe not. This is a non-traditional memoir, filled with alphabetical vignettes not chronological ones. I have made a foray into fiction with an asterisk: in those cases where I have marked the vignette as fictional, it might be 100 percent not true, but in many cases I knew of, was part of, or heard from others about the story itself. At any rate, the entire book is my recollection of things past, and as in all recollections, the more distant the memory the clearer the details.

A man patiently watches a group of young girls walk home from school, waiting for the perfect moment to take the one child he has designated as his next victim. However, what this predator does not know is that he, too, is being stalked. There is someone in the shadows—a trained Citizen—who is ready to make sure that the child under his assigned protection is never harmed. One pedophile, one abuser, one killer at a time; this Citizen and others like him will take a stand against those who prey on the weak and the innocent.

When the author's mother died he discovered over 200 letters in a shoe box that his father had written to her during their separation during World War II. Captain Lashley was stationed first at a hospital in England as a supply officer and then as the commander of a prisoner of war camp in France. During those months his letters tell of the events of his life. Some are boring and seem to be of little consequence, others are filled with emotional turmoil. Rene Lashley, his wife, has his fourth child while he is away, moves in with her mother and sister and raises her other three children. Kirk, the second son, is puzzled by what is happening, but continues doing those things a normal child does. The book is an effort to show the common, everyday concerns of all the family members in what is an unprecedented time in the life of the family and the world. The story is told through the voices of the soldier, the mom, and the child.

The novel's protagonist is a British Roman Catholic priest, Father Percy Franklin, who looks identical to the mysterious U.S. Senator Julian Felsenburgh of Vermont. The senator appears as a lone and dramatic figure promising world peace in return for blind obedience. No one quite knows who he is or where he comes from, but his voice mesmerizes. Under his leadership, war is abolished. Felsenburgh becomes the President of Europe, then of the world, by popular acclaim. Everyone is fascinated with him, yet still no one knows much about him. People are both riveted and frightened by the way he demands attention. Most follow without question. Having been a close observer of President Felsenburgh's rise, Father Franklin is called to Rome, a Hong Kong-style enclave ruled by Pope John XXVI and raised to the College of Cardinals. Meanwhile, defections among bishops and priests increase. At Cardinal Franklin's instigation, the pope abolishes the Eastern Catholic Churches and forms a new religious order, the Order of Christ Crucified. All its members, including the Pope, vow to die in the name of the faith.

Mary's girlfriend helped them to get into Canada, but they had to show up \$10,000, which was not easy to accumulate. When they obtained the money, they were able to fly to Canada. They settled down in Toronto. Joe was lucky because he got an engineering job soon and he was able to support his family. Joe got sick again and could not walk for a while, but with excellent treatment and positive thinking, he was able to overcome his problem. He and his wife graduated as interior designers and started a new business. After some good years, the bad years came. Due to the recession, Joe and Mary lost their business. This book is the description of a personal journey via South Africa to an academic sabbatical sojourn in the cities of Bologna and Modena in the region of Emilia-Romagna in Italy. The book has evolved out of the compilation of a sequential diary of this journey. Within the text I am trying to relate not only my personal experiences but how I saw the multitude of social, economic and bureaucratic interactions that makes living in central Italy so wonderful, but innately frustrating. Based on my extended experiences in Africa working on AIDS programs as a physician my pre-Italian experiences provided me with the opportunity to comment through my visions of the world upon some of the important social issues. I began my experiences with the Italian bureaucracy in Tasmania and Melbourne while I prepared for my sabbatical at Modena University, long before I arrived in Italy with my wife. It was here I had to obtain the first of the multitude of documents that are essential to function as an employee in Italy. These initial documents were the Schengen visa and a Nulla Osta. Over time I observed and experienced how the Italian bureaucracy can create quivering wrecks of grown women and men who would normally hold audiences in the palms of their hands. As a resident in Bologna this meant I was taking a daily trip by train to Modena and within the hustle and bustle of train platforms, almost non-decipherable public address systems and crowded buses, I was forced with my limited Italian to get to the right place at the right time on the correct train. I saw how the influence of social class and the "friend of a friend" (l'amico dell'amico) phenomenon and the wearing of suits and ties allowed me to bypass, overcome and also fail to overcome Italian administrative speed bumps. I have felt the generosity of spirit of the Italians in welcoming us into the intimacy of their commercial lives such as restaurants and markets and coming to our assistance when in distress (e.g. when my wife was trapped on a train). Despite these barriers I became employed within the Italian health system with a genuine "codice fiscale" (work number) and as a couple we immersed ourselves in the food and culture of Italy which was defined to me by a friend as the "birthplace of modern civilisation." In this book I document how I have experienced the joys of attaining a childhood dream in the partial acquisition of a second language and to function with that skill in the country of its origin. I truly am experiencing a fortunate life.
