What part does technological knowledge accumulation play in modern economic growth? This book investigates and examines the predictions of new growth theory, using OECD manufacturing data. Its empirical findings portray a novel and complex picture of the features of long-term growth, where technological knowledge production and diffusion play a central part, alongside variations in capital and employment. A parallel examination of long-run trade patterns and government policy issues completes a broader account of how knowledge-based growth in industrial output is at the heart of modern economic prosperity.

The book 2016 Annual Competitiveness Analysis and Growth Slowdown Analysis for ASEAN-10 begins by presenting the insights of Mr George Yeo, Former Minister for Foreign Affairs of Singapore,

Ten years after the GFC crisis, this is a timely review of the reform agenda, the progress made, and the areas where further changes need to be made to

address new risks and challenges.

Which political and institutional factors trigger reforms that enable the poor to benefit from the process of economic growth? How can the incentives of policy makers be influenced in order to achieve such a dynamic? These are the questions this study seeks to address by examining the transition process in post-communist countries. The author argues that political competition within an accepted and respected institutional environment has been a driving force in shaping the direction and success of transition reforms. Evidence shows that in countries with a sufficient degree of political competition, citizens responded to economic crises by calling for economic liberalization. Economic liberalization removed existing distortions, increased economic efficiency and raised public welfare. This activated a dynamic, self-enforcing reform process that also strengthened the political and economic power of the poor. In the absence of political competition, such a process failed to emerge, thereby contributing to the persistence of poverty. Based on these findings, there is good reason to postulate that some level of political competition is essential for transition reforms to improve economic efficiency and public welfare in a sustainable manner.

The first step in sermon journaling is to Assess Your Spiritual Mindset at the time you hear the sermon. This is done by taking inventory of where you are emotionally, mentally, and spiritually. Doing so right before you hear the message will help you gauge your receptivity to what God wants to say to you. The second step is the actual note taking as you listen to the sermon. This is where you will Write Down the Main Points of the Message including personal insights that God reveals to you through the Holy Spirit. The third step is Writing Down How You Will Apply the Sermon to your spiritual journey. The key to your growth as a Christian is to apply the Biblical principles that you hear proclaimed. The fourth step is to Share with Others What God is Teaching You. Ask God to open your eyes to those you know who would benefit spiritually if you were to share with them the truth of this message. Your sermon journal becomes a discipling resource that you can draw upon as you

minister to others. Taking these steps in documenting the truth of scripture that you hear will help you grow in your faith and result in a deeper relationship with the Lord.
