Today, the incarcerated population is 4.5 times larger than in 1980, with approximately 2.2 million people in the United States behind bars, including individuals in Federal and State prisons as well as local jails. Economic analysis is a useful lens for understanding the costs, benefits, and consequences of incarceration and other criminal justice policies.
